



Certificate Programme

Bursary Fund

The bursary fund is intended for students who cannot afford the full cost of the tuition fees for the Certificate Programme in Conversational Ministry and Biblical Counselling, and whose local church has insufficient funds to cover the student's shortfall.

The fund will normally match the contribution to their fees that a student's local church is giving them, up to 1/3 of the cost of the tuition fees.

The fund is run on a first-come, first-served basis. Bursaries will normally be awarded for all the courses yet to be taken in that current academic year.

New students can apply once they have received confirmation of a place on the course.

Priority will be given to students intending to complete at least two certificates in the course programme.

To apply:

1. The student should email courses@bcuk.org with details of the financial support their church is providing.
2. The student's pastor should email courses@bcuk.org to confirm the level of financial support and outline the reasons the church is unable to meet the student's shortfall.
